- 3 The burning coal scattered over the city of Jerusalem was a picture of judgment( the city would be burned by Babylonians) and the burning coal touched on the mouth of prophet \_\_ was for purification.
- 6 The Lord would change the Israelite's heart of stone to a heart of \_\_.
- 7 The description of the throne, expanse, cherubim, and wheels are the same as the one in Ezekiel-1, except one of the faces of the living creature is like the \_\_ instead of an ox.(compare v14&22)
- 10 Ezekiel's seventh symbolic action was to act out the captivity of the remaining people in \_\_. He had to pack his belongings during the daytime and while the exiles watched he had to escape through a hole that he dug on the wall.
- 11 Ezekiel 8-11 is the record of a long vision, which occurred \_\_ year after the vision mentioned in Ezekiel 1.
- 12 Even when the people were in exile they were still \_\_. There were false prophets in Jerusalem and the people listened to them(Jerusalem would not be destroyed) rather than listening to God's prophets.
- 15 When Cherubim were standing on the south side of the temple, the cloud of God's glory rose above the Cherubim and it filled the temple. This cloud is often called the \_\_ glory. This is the cloud that filled the Tabernacle, Solomon's temple, and from which God spoke to Moses. Kristheeya keerthanangal 284 stanza6
- 17 The prince among them exiting through the hole in a wall covering the face represent Zedekiah in desperation trying to escape from \_\_, but he was caught and His eyes were taken out.
- 18 Ezekiel saw the Glory of God at the entrance to the north gate of the inner court(Ez.9:3), then to the south side of the temple(10:4), from there it moved to the east gate(10:19), and finally, it hovered over the mount of \_\_ (Zac.14:4) east of Jerusalem Temple and disappeared(11:23).
- 19 The exiles would return to Israel and remove all the detestable idols. The Lord would give them an \_\_ heart and put a new spirit in them.
- 20 "Woe to the \_\_ prophets who follow their own spirit and have seen nothing!" Deut. 18:21-22.
- 21 Ezekiel's eighth symbolic act was to tremble as he ate his food and \_\_ in fear as he drinks water. This is to show the fearfulness and terror of siege and captivity.

- 8 In the vision the spirit lifted Ezekiel up and took him to Jerusalem and then brought him back to the exiles in \_\_.
- 9 Zedekiah was called the prince because he was not the legitimate king. He was appointed by Nebuchadnezzar. \_\_ was considered as the last king of Judah before Babylon exile. Matt.1
- 10 Ezekiel thought that the remnant of Israel were the people remaining in \_\_. But the Lord assured him that the true remnant is the people, who went to exile and the Lord would bring them back to Israel again. [Jer.29:10-19]
- 13 "The days go by and every \_\_ comes to nothing" was the proverb in the land meaning that the prophecies of doom would never happen. But the Lord said that the days are near when every \_\_ would be fulfilled without delay.
- 14 The false leaders were saying, "Will it not soon be time to build houses?" Probably they were mocking \_\_ because he had told the Israelites to build houses in Babylon as they would be there for a long time.
- 16 Jaazaniah and \_\_ were the leaders of the people giving wicked advice to the remnant in Jerusalem. \_\_ dies as Ezekiel was prophesying.
